Bed Alarm Education



In an effort to minimize patient injuries due to a fall, <u>ALL</u> patients will be assessed and scored for fall risk using the criteria per the Schmid Fall Risk Tool.

All patients having procedures or surgery with sedation or anesthesia in areas to include Surgery, GI Lab, PACU, Cath Lab, and Interventional Radiology are considered at risk for falls and standard risk interventions will be initiated by the RN upon arrival to pre-op and holding room areas.

<u>Physicians can help by encouraging patient's to embrace the bed alarms and</u> continue to work with the unit nursing staff regarding interventions implemented.

Restraint Policy Update

Dear Medical Staff,

Restraint Policy Update:

Our restraint policy could have been interpreted to indicate that mittens are not a restraint unless they are tied down. However, mittens ARE a form of restraint, even if they are not tied down. As a result, our restraint policy has been updated. Restraints may not be initiated without a physician order and will require daily order renewal.

Below is the regulatory definition of what qualifies mittens as restraints.

Hand Mitts

Hand mitts would be considered a restraint if:

- The mitts are pinned or otherwise attached to the bed/bedding or are used in conjunction with wrist restraints and/or
- The mitts are applied so tightly that the patient's hands or fingers are immobilized, and/or
- The mitts are so bulky that the patient's ability to use their hands is significantly reduced, and/or
- The mitts cannot be easily removed intentionally by the patient in the same manner they were applied by staff considering the patient's physical condition and ability to accomplish the objective.

Acute TTP

An opportunity for improvement was identified to better serve our Acute thrombotic thrombocytopenic purpura (TTP) patients.

Below you will find a new order set for the ordering of Emergency Plasmapheresis (Acute TTP) along with the explanation of its use. These orders are currently active in Power Chart. If you have any questions, please contact Gina Sulmeyer and she can assist you.

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The emergency order set contains five STAT orders:

- 1. MD to RN Contact the plasmapheresis nurse: Same original order but priority of STAT
- 2. MD to RN order to notify the House Supervisor of need for immediate monitored bed placement
- 3. Medication order to pharmacy for the Albumin infusion with instructions to contact the plasmapheresis nurse for quantity and sends immediate notification to the pharmacy
- 4. FFP Order to Blood Bank with instructions to contact RN for volume but gives them immediate notification to prepare
- 5. Correct radiology order for line placement with instructions

This emergency subphase creates STAT notification of all involved departments with one order. It will require education of the hospitalists to use the order but otherwise will be automatic.

Assessment:

The VitalEEG machine allows for quick and rapid deployment. The Respiratory department can initiate the VitalEEG during the EEG department afterhours.

Recommendation:

If the VitalEEG is required and ordered, please contact the **Respiratory Lead at extension x76718**.

Vital EEG Inclusion Criteria:

- Unconscious and/or unresponsive patient in the ED or ICU and;
- All other EEG equipment are in use and/or;
- EEG required afterhours

EEG Department Afterhours:

- Monday—Thursday 20:30 to 06:00
- Friday—Saturday 22:00 to 07:00

Who: All staff, physicians, and advanced providers who work with unconscious inpatients.
