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


#### **Torrance Community View**

Hello all,

As your Executive Director of Medical Informatics, I am your physician liaison to all things Cerner Millennium. With an experienced team of informaticists and service specialists supporting me, we are available to assist you with questions or ideas regarding use of the electronic medical record across both the acute and ambulatory locations of the Torrance Memorial Health System.

I wanted to remind the new users and update experienced users about our Health Information Exchange, called Torrance Community View. Torrance Community View provides outside patient records provided by participating organization. As of now, we have over 300 participating organizations contributing information to our system in real time.

You will find Torrance Community View in the dark gray area on the far left of the patient chart. You may need to hover over the "Menu" button at the top to expand the dark gray area. To keep it expanded, click the "thumbtack" icon at the top. Each position will find the title of Torrance Community View in a slightly different location, so just look for yours.



At the very top of Torrance Community View you will see a header that shows the source of information available on a patient. The four sources are Cedars-Sinai, Commonwell, Memorial Care and Aggregated CCD. Cedars-Sinai and Memorial Care contain direct information form these institutions. Commonwell combines several dozen participating providers to collect data. Aggregated CCD is another source of data from combined providers. These currently include UCLA, several Kaiser facilities, and multiple smaller institutions. A green OK indicates information is present. A red N/F or a blue N/D indicates Not Found or No Data.

## **Medical Informatics**

The second line of blue boxes are drop down filters to narrow your search. For example, you can select only Cedars-Sinai data under the Sources filter.



Next in Torrance Community View, you will see a Summary Page at the top of the screen. Here you will find quick access to recent Vital Signs, Allergies, Problem Lists, Lab Results, and Documents. Clicking on any blue title will open the document or result for you. The Summary Page defaults to the past 24 months but has filters available to change the view.

What started as a superficial scratch 51uear-old Oscar Gallardo made on his left toe last June while swimming in a pool turned out to be so much more. After several days of self-care, he noticed discoloration at the scratch site had spread throughout his forefoot. Having underlying diabetes since childhood, he became concerned and made an appointment to see his physician. He was told not to worry, was treated with creams and told not to wear shoes to give his foot a chance to heal. After nearly five months of treatment, an infection developed. He feared he would lose his entire foot. At this point, he sought help at Torrance Memorial's Burn, Wound Healing and Amputation Prevention Center - where he found life and limb-saving care. "From the moment I met Dr. Karen Shum, I told her I would do anything to save my foot," said Gallardo.

Dr. Shum quickly diagnosed a vascular blockage previously missed, which prevented his healing. A vascular procedure was done to clear the vessel blockage. Dr. Shum told him a transmetatarsal amputation to remove the infected toes, was necessary. She would try to preserve as much of his foot as possible to enable ambulation with a functional limb. From proper diagnosis and problem-solving to surgery, Gallardo found the care at Torrance Memorial to be very good and personal. "I found the confidence I needed and received life-saving care," said Gallardo. The team at Torrance Memorial gave him the reassurance that he was finally getting the right care. Dr. Shum even arranged for state-of-the-art hyperbaric oxygen therapy to prevent further infection and promote healing. Gallardo is now making a full recovery.

He was also inspired to make personal lifestyle changes by exercising routinely and improving his diet. Today, he has lost nearly 65 lbs. and feels like he has his life back – not to mention the preservation of his left foot. Gallardo has been able to return to work and credits the team at Torrance Memorial Wound Healing and Amputation Prevention Center for saving his foot and enabling him to walk again.
