## **MEDICAL STAFF ASSISTANCE PROGRAM**

Torrance Memorial Medical Staff provides members of the Medical Staff with professional and confidential assistance through a Medical Staff Assistance Program (MSAP) at no cost to members for ten (10) crisis and intervention visits per calendar year. This service proves members with a constructive way to deal with personal problems which may be affecting behavior and clinical performance. It is the belief that dealing with these problems preemptively may alleviate issues related to clinical performance, clinical privileges and/or membership. However, member involvement in this or any other rehabilitation program does not excuse or limit the obligation of members to meet Torrance Memorial Medical Staff's Bylaws, Rules and Regulations and polices/procedures or standards.

Eligible Medical Staff members may self-refer to the Program by calling Gelbart and Associates at (310) 257-5751. Inquiries will be held in strictest confidence.

Self-referrals are limited to up to ten (10) visits to program counselors. The program counselor may immediately refer clients to a qualified professional in the community for continued care after an initial assessment, if the counselor determines that more than ten (10) visits are necessary.

Need to talk through a difficult situation you have encountered? A case that is bothering you? Or perhaps a personal issue that has been difficult to process?



Re: New Test –  $HIT_{(PF4-H)}$  Assay

Dear Medical Staff, Physicians, and Pharmacy Staff,

We are delighted to inform you of the inclusion of the HIT(PF4-H) Assay in our coagulation menu. Commencing January 9th, 2024, this screening test will be conducted on our existing WERFEN ACL TOP 550 analyzer. For presumed positive results, a reflex to the Mayo confirmatory send-out test SRAU (Serotonin Release Assay) will be initiated for confirmation.

The HIT assay will be accessible 24/7. It's important to note that this test cannot be added to previously processed coagulation samples. Additionally, a red top tube must be drawn simultaneously for potential confirmation.

HIT (Heparin-Induced Thrombocytopenia) is an immune complex-mediated disorder that poses risks of morbidity and mortality in patients undergoing heparin therapy. Despite anticoagulants being administered to prevent thrombosis, HIT's major clinical event is an elevated risk of venous and/or arterial thrombosis. Suspicions arise when patients on unfractionated heparin (UHF) or low molecular weight heparin (LMWH) exhibit a platelet count decrease exceeding 50% from baseline, typically between day 5 and 10 of anticoagulant initiation. Early-onset and delayed-onset HIT cases have also been reported. A timely diagnosis is crucial, as heparin treatment must be halted, and alternative anticoagulants employed upon confirmed HIT.

Anti-PF4/H antibody testing, coupled with a thorough clinical assessment, proves invaluable in managing suspected HIT patients. A negative result for the anti-PF4/H antibody test supports the clinical decision to rule out HIT, allowing the continuation of heparin treatment.

## **Important Reminder**

# Staff and Physicians must use the **TMMC-Guest** wireless network with any personal device



#### This includes:

- · Personal iPhone & Android phones
- Personal laptop computers
- Personal Apple & Android tablets
- Any non-TMMC device

#### Benefits of using the TMMC-Guest wireless network:





- Protects the organization by completely separating an individual's personal computing using unauthorized devices from our protected production network.
- · Is encrypted the same way the TMMC production network is to provide data security
- Does not have bandwidth restrictions
- Requires re-authentication every 7 days to keep the network additionally secure

#### Mobile Heartbeat on Personal Cellular Devices:

If wireless connectivity is lost the device will use cellular to continue to receive notifications.

For security Mobile Heartbeat logs users out after 7 days of use.

User must log back into Mobile Heartbeat to continue receiving notifications.
